* Social Communication Groups – For these sessions, parents must attend and be part of the session. The purpose of these sessions is an opportunity for parents to have a therapist explain and support key developmental skills, eg: social interaction, attention and listening, play and understanding use of language.

Phonics Booster – During this 5-day course we will be running our Sound Smart Programme. This is ideal for children who struggle with phonics.

Literacy Booster - Ideal for key stage 1 and 2, looking at strategies for reading comprehension, inferencing, verbal reasoning.

Story and Play – Ideal for younger children; a sensory story including elements of drama and craft. * 1:1 sessions – £65 for 45 minutes (recommended for existing clients). We will be able to offer 1:1 sessions throughout the time we are open. We recommend a minimum of 3 sessions be booked (we cannot guarantee you will have the same therapist throughout).

* Assessments – From £220. If your child requires an assessment prior to starting their next school year, we will be able to offer this service. Please call Emma to book this and discuss which assessment will be required.

* Consultancy sessions – This is a great opportunity to come and meet a therapist and talk through your concerns and allow the therapists to do some informal assessing, give you advice, model some strategies, discuss next steps of support and take home some resources to work on.
