Annual Report 2016

This year has had a very positive collection of OR events, building on last year the Society is now in a great position to continue its regeneration.

Report from Membership Secretary

The database now holds records for 7,060 Old Russellians, 241 more than last year. The Alumni Association (AROPS) provided some very positive and helpful information regarding the use of the database, the new law coming into force in 2018, and where we all stand with regards to confidentiality. Adrian Edwards (Secretary) and Sue Tanner (Membership Secretary) attended conferences at Malvern St James and later Sue Tanner attended Eton. The AROPS AGM in October was attended by Brian Angel (OR President) and Adrian Edwards.

In accordance with the 2014 Rules which were adopted at the 2014 AGM, all ex pupils are deemed Old Russellians and no membership is taken. This was a decision made by the Headmaster jointly with the Operations Director in the summer of 2015. We are still receiving 'donations' from 90 O.R.s, we have lost 7 subscribers over the past 12 months.

The school's website, which went live in March 2015, is kept updated by Sue Tanner. Over the past year, we have averaged 280 hits per month, with the highest being in June with 432 hits. Other big months were September (329) and April (385).

The Mailchimp email system now delivers information to 1,434 Old Russellians around the world on a regular basis and the open rate averages 44%. The new method for texting O.R.s introduced last year, through a company called TextLocal, delivers texts to 314 O.R.s and ex staff, nearly double the number we held last year. We have had no opt-outs from this system. Sue has recently taken over the O.R. generic Facebook page and after the riverside reunion in June we received 1700 'Likes' from this page, and more recently 1100 'Reached' after the 1970s reunion.

The newsletter is produced towards the middle of each term, and is available to download on the website. It is sent out by mail to 29 Old Russellians without computers, and also displayed in the school common room and distributed amongst some of the longer serving members of staff.
