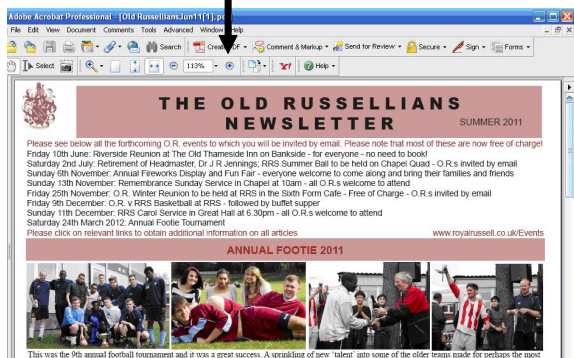

Dr John Jennings Headmaster 1996-2001



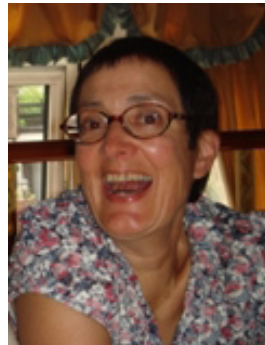
